

## Drug and Alcohol Awareness Display and Presentation

Working alone or with a partner, you will research and prepare both a presentation and display focused on a selected substance. Your objective is to teach your peers about the nature of that substance and provide worthwhile information for them to use in understanding its dangers.

Your presentation will use PowerPoint (ambitious, you can use Prezi). You will use a poster like product for the display portion.

The task:

- Choose a substance to showcase which has evidence of abuse. It can be any substance, uncontrolled, controlled or illegal. See me for approval before beginning. Each group needs a different topic.
- Use the handout to help summarize your findings. Consider aspects of substance abuse beyond those laid out in the document.
- Be, at minimum, to include and illustrate the following areas.
  - a. Name and general description
  - b. Legitimate uses *if any* and a description of its restrictions if any (e.g. for alcohol, you must be 19 to purchase and consume it)
  - c. Where it is produced and how it is distributed
  - d. Costs to buy – both legitimate and/or street values
  - e. Effects on the body including short and long term and include any challenges to ceasing usage
- Submit two quiz style questions that could be answered after viewing the presentation and display.
- Place on the back of the display, an alphabetized “Resource List” of all sources used and/or cited for both the presentation and display.
  - a. It is important that you use quality, edited sources. Ensure that your resources are trustworthy.

Feel free to make worthwhile additions or ask if you are uncertain about any aspect.
