

Reading Checklist - note the requirements

The reading program is designed to improve your skills and expand your exposure. Some class time is scheduled for reading. For the most part, you select your books with the stipulation that Mr. Pratte may need to approve them. Be sure you understand the requirements detailed below.

1. Choose age appropriate material, no Captain Underpants, etc. Not sure? Ask! Select across genres. For each group of five, at least one must be non-fiction (e.g. biography, informational, history, etc.) and read before moving to the next group. **ONLY ONE GRAPHIC NOVEL PER GROUP MAX**
2. You must average 2 books/month for a minimum total of 20 by June 15
3. Books over 400 pages count as two books (leave a blank on the next line)
4. You will use this list for book talks - it must be recorded here and read this school year
5. Use my website for help. E.g. book selection, using the public library online
