

Reading Checklist - note the requirements

The reading program is designed to develop skills and expand your exposure. Some class time is scheduled for reading. For the most part, you select your own books. Sometimes, Mr. Pratte may need to approve them if planning to use them for class work.

1. Choose age appropriate material, no Captain Underpants, etc. 😊 Not sure? Ask! Select across genres. For each group of five, at least one must be non-fiction (e.g. biography, informational, history, etc.). Complete each section before moving on. Graphic novels are OK but only one per group max. (check out Hoopla for a great selection)
2. You must average 2 books/month for a minimum total of 20 by June 11
3. Books over 400 pages count as two books (just leave a blank on the next line)
4. You will use this list for several assignments - books must be recorded here
5. Use my website for help. E.g. book selection, using the public library online
